- 1 O give thanks unto the LORD, for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- 2 Let the <u>redeemed</u> of the LORD say so, whom he hath redeemed from the <u>hand</u> of the <u>enemy</u>;
- 3 And gathered them *out* of the <u>lands</u>, from the *east*, and from the *west*, from the *north*, and from the *south*.
- 4 They <u>wandered</u> in the <u>wilderness</u> in a <u>solitary way</u>; they <u>found no city</u> to <u>dwell</u> in.
- 5 Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them.
- 6 Then they <u>cried</u> unto the **LORD** in their <u>trouble</u>, and he <u>delivered</u> them *out* of their <u>distresses</u>.
- 7 And he <u>led</u> them forth by the <u>right way</u>, that they might go to a <u>city</u> of <u>habitation</u>.
- Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- 9 For he <u>satisfieth</u> the *longing* <u>soul</u>, and <u>filleth</u> the <u>hungry</u> soul with <u>goodness</u>.
- 10 Such as sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, being bound in affliction and iron;
- ¹¹ Because they rebelled against the words of God, and contemned the counsel of the most High:
- 12 Therefore he brought *down* their <u>heart</u> with <u>labour</u>; they <u>fell</u> *down*, and there was <u>none</u> to <u>help</u>.
- 13 Then they <u>cried</u> unto the LORD in their <u>trouble</u>, and he <u>saved</u> them *out* of their <u>distresses</u>.
- 14 He brought them *out* of <u>darkness</u> and the <u>shadow</u> of <u>death</u>, and <u>brake</u> their <u>bands</u> in *sunder*.
- 15 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- 16 For he hath broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in *sunder*.
- 17 Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted.
- 18 Their <u>soul abhorreth</u> all <u>manner</u> of <u>meat</u>; and they <u>draw</u> <u>near</u> unto the <u>gates</u> of <u>death</u>.
- 19 Then they <u>cry</u> unto the **LORD** in their <u>trouble</u>, and he <u>saveth</u> them *out* of their <u>distresses</u>.
- 20 He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.
- ²¹ Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!

- 22 And let them <u>sacrifice</u> the sacrifices of <u>thanksgiving</u>, and <u>declare</u> his <u>works</u> with <u>rejoicing</u>.
- 23 They that go *down* to the <u>sea</u> in <u>ships</u>, that do <u>business</u> in *great* <u>waters</u>;
- 24 These *see* the <u>works</u> of the LORD, and his <u>wonders</u> in the <u>deep</u>.
- 25 For he commandeth, and raiseth the stormy wind, which lifteth up the waves thereof.
- 26 They mount up to the heaven, they go down again to the depths: their soul is melted because of trouble.
- 27 They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and are at their wit's end.
- 28 Then they <u>cry</u> unto the **LORD** in their <u>trouble</u>, and he bringeth them *out* of their <u>distresses</u>.
- 29 He maketh the <u>storm</u> a <u>calm</u>, so that the <u>waves</u> thereof are *still*.
- 30 Then are they glad because they be quiet; so he bringeth them unto their desired haven.
- 31 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- 32 Let them <u>exalt</u> him also in the <u>congregation</u> of the people, and <u>praise</u> him in the <u>assembly</u> of the <u>elders</u>.
- 33 He <u>turneth rivers</u> into a <u>wilderness</u>, and the <u>watersprings</u> into <u>dry ground</u>;
- 34 A *fruitful* land into <u>barrenness</u>, for the <u>wickedness</u> of them that <u>dwell</u> therein.
- 35 He <u>turneth</u> the <u>wilderness</u> into a <u>standing water</u>, and <u>dry ground</u> into <u>watersprings</u>.
- 36 And there he maketh the <u>hungry</u> to <u>dwell</u>, that they may <u>prepare</u> a <u>city</u> for <u>habitation</u>;
- 37 And sow the fields, and plant vineyards, which may yield fruits of increase.
- 38 He <u>blesseth</u> them also, so that they are <u>multiplied</u> <u>greatly</u>, and <u>suffereth not</u> their <u>cattle</u> to <u>decrease</u>.
- 39 Again, they are *minished* and brought *low* through <u>oppression</u>, <u>affliction</u>, and <u>sorrow</u>.
- 40 He <u>poureth contempt</u> upon <u>princes</u>, and causeth them to <u>wander</u> in the <u>wilderness</u>, where there is <u>no way</u>.
- 41 Yet setteth he the poor on *high* from affliction, and maketh him families like a flock.
- 42 The <u>righteous</u> shall *see* it, and <u>rejoice</u>: and *all* <u>iniquity</u> shall <u>stop</u> her <u>mouth</u>.
- 43 Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the lovingkindness of the LORD.

- 1 O God, my heart is fixed; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory.
- 2 Awake, psaltery and harp: I myself will awake early.
- 3 I will <u>praise</u> thee, O LORD, among the people: and I will <u>sing</u> praises unto thee among the <u>nations</u>.
- 4 For thy mercy is great above the heavens: and thy truth reacheth unto the clouds.
- 5 Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens: and thy glory above all the earth;
- 6 That thy <u>beloved</u> may be <u>delivered</u>: <u>save</u> with thy <u>right hand</u>, and <u>answer</u> me.
- 7 God hath spoken in his holiness; I will rejoice, I will divide Shechem, and mete out the valley of Succoth.
- 8 Gilead is mine; Manasseh is mine; Ephraim also is the <u>strength</u> of mine <u>head</u>; Judah is my <u>lawgiver</u>;
- ⁹ Moab is my <u>washpot</u>; over Edom will I <u>cast</u> out my <u>shoe</u>; over Philistia will I <u>triumph</u>.
- 10 Who will bring me into the *strong* city? who will <u>lead</u> me into **Edom**?
- ¹¹ Wilt <u>not</u> thou, O God, who hast <u>cast</u> us off? and wilt <u>not</u> thou, O God, go forth with our <u>hosts</u>?
- 12 Give us <u>help</u> from <u>trouble</u>: for <u>vain</u> is the help of <u>man</u>.
- 13 Through God we shall do *valiantly*: for he it is that shall <u>tread</u> *down* our <u>enemies</u>.

- ¹ Hold not thy peace, O God of my praise;
- ² For the <u>mouth</u> of the <u>wicked</u> and the mouth of the <u>deceitful</u> are <u>opened against</u> me: they have spoken <u>against</u> me with a <u>lying tongue</u>.
- 3 They <u>compassed</u> me about also with <u>words</u> of <u>hatred</u>; and <u>fought against</u> me without a <u>cause</u>.
- 4 For my <u>love</u> they are my <u>adversaries</u>: but I give myself unto <u>prayer</u>.
- 5 And they have <u>rewarded</u> me <u>evil</u> for good, and <u>hatred</u> for my <u>love</u>.
- Set thou a <u>wicked man</u> over him: and let <u>Satan stand</u> at his <u>right hand</u>.
- 7 When he shall be <u>judged</u>, let him be <u>condemned</u>: and let his <u>prayer</u> become <u>sin</u>.
- 8 Let his <u>days</u> be <u>few</u>; and let <u>another</u> take his <u>office</u>.
- ⁹ Let his children be <u>fatherless</u>, and his <u>wife</u> a <u>widow</u>.
- 10 Let his children be *continually <u>vagabonds</u>*, and <u>beg</u>: let them <u>seek</u> their <u>bread</u> also *out* of their <u>desolate</u> <u>places</u>.
- 11 Let the extortioner catch all that he hath; and let the strangers spoil his labour.
- 12 Let there be none to extend mercy unto him: neither let there be any to favour his fatherless children.
- 13 Let his posterity be cut off; and in the generation following let their name be blotted out.
- 14 Let the <u>iniquity</u> of his <u>fathers</u> be <u>remembered</u> with the <u>LORD</u>; and let <u>not</u> the <u>sin</u> of his <u>mother</u> be <u>blotted</u> out.
- 15 Let them be *before* the LORD *continually*, that he may <u>cut</u> off the <u>memory</u> of them from the <u>earth</u>.
- 16 Because that he <u>remembered not</u> to shew <u>mercy</u>, but <u>persecuted</u> the <u>poor</u> and <u>needy man</u>, that he might even <u>slay</u> the <u>broken</u> in <u>heart</u>.
- 17 As he <u>loved cursing</u>, so let it come unto him: as he <u>delighted not</u> in <u>blessing</u>, so let it be *far* from him.
- 18 As he <u>clothed</u> himself with <u>cursing</u> like as with his <u>garment</u>, so let it come into his <u>bowels</u> like <u>water</u>, and like <u>oil</u> into his <u>bones</u>.
- 19 Let it be unto him as the <u>garment</u> which <u>covereth</u> him, and for a <u>girdle</u> wherewith he is <u>girded</u> continually.

- 20 Let this be the <u>reward</u> of mine <u>adversaries</u> from the LORD, and of them that speak <u>evil against</u> my <u>soul</u>.
- 21 But do thou for me, O GOD the Lord, for thy <u>name's</u> sake: because thy <u>mercy</u> is <u>good</u>, <u>deliver</u> thou me.
- 22 For I am <u>poor</u> and <u>needy</u>, and my <u>heart</u> is <u>wounded</u> within me.
- 23 I am gone like the <u>shadow</u> when it <u>declineth</u>: I am <u>tossed</u> *up* and *down* as the <u>locust</u>.
- 24 My knees are weak through fasting; and my flesh faileth of fatness.
- ²⁵ I became also a <u>reproach</u> unto them: when they looked upon me they <u>shaked</u> their <u>heads</u>.
- 26 Help me, O LORD my God: O save me according to thy mercy:
- 27 That they may know that this is thy hand; that thou, LORD, hast done it.
- 28 Let them <u>curse</u>, but <u>bless</u> thou: when they <u>arise</u>, let them be <u>ashamed</u>; but let thy <u>servant rejoice</u>.
- 29 Let mine <u>adversaries</u> be <u>clothed</u> with <u>shame</u>, and let them <u>cover</u> themselves with their *own* <u>confusion</u>, as with a mantle.
- 30 I will *greatly* <u>praise</u> the LORD with my <u>mouth</u>; yea, I will <u>praise</u> him among the <u>multitude</u>.
- 31 For he shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to save him from those that condemn his soul.

- 1 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.
- 2 The LORD shall send the rod of thy strength *out* of **Zion**: rule thou in the *midst* of thine enemies.
- 3 Thy people shall be <u>willing</u> in the <u>day</u> of thy <u>power</u>, in the <u>beauties</u> of <u>holiness</u> from the <u>womb</u> of the <u>morning</u>: thou hast the <u>dew</u> of thy <u>youth</u>.
- 4 The LORD hath <u>sworn</u>, and will <u>not repent</u>, Thou art a <u>priest for ever after the <u>order</u> of Melchizedek.</u>
- ⁵ The Lord at thy <u>right hand</u> shall <u>strike</u> through <u>kings</u> in the <u>day</u> of his <u>wrath</u>.
- 6 He shall judge among the heathen, he shall fill the places with the dead bodies; he shall wound the heads over many countries.
- 7 He shall <u>drink</u> of the <u>brook</u> in the <u>way</u>: therefore shall he <u>lift</u> *up* the <u>head</u>.

- 1 Praise ye the LORD. I will praise the LORD with my whole heart, in the assembly of the upright, and in the congregation.
- 2 The works of the LORD are great, sought out of all them that have pleasure therein.
- 3 His work is honourable and glorious: and his righteousness endureth for ever.
- 4 He hath made his *wonderful* works to be <u>remembered</u>: the LORD is <u>gracious</u> and <u>full</u> of <u>compassion</u>.
- 5 He hath given meat unto them that fear him: he will ever be mindful of his covenant.
- 6 He hath shewed his people the <u>power</u> of his <u>works</u>, that he may give them the <u>heritage</u> of the <u>heathen</u>.
- 7 The works of his hands are verity and judgment; all his commandments are sure.
- They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in truth and uprightness.
- 9 He <u>sent redemption</u> unto his people: he hath <u>commanded</u> his <u>covenant</u> *for ever*. <u>holy and <u>reverend</u> is his name.</u>
- 10 The <u>fear</u> of the LORD is the <u>beginning</u> of <u>wisdom</u>: a <u>good understanding</u> have <u>all</u> they that do his <u>commandments</u>: his <u>praise endureth</u> <u>for ever</u>.

- 1 Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments.
- ² His <u>seed</u> shall be <u>mighty</u> upon <u>earth</u>: the <u>generation</u> of the <u>upright</u> shall be <u>blessed</u>.
- 3 Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endureth for ever.
- 4 Unto the <u>upright</u> there <u>ariseth light</u> in the <u>darkness</u>: he is <u>gracious</u>, and <u>full</u> of <u>compassion</u>, and <u>righteous</u>.
- 5 A *good* man sheweth favour, and lendeth: he will guide his affairs with discretion.
- 6 Surely he shall not be moved for ever. the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance.
- 7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD.
- 8 His heart is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon his enemies.
- ⁹ He hath <u>dispersed</u>, he hath given to the <u>poor</u>; his <u>righteousness endureth</u> *for ever*, his <u>horn</u> shall be <u>exalted</u> with <u>honour</u>.
- 10 The <u>wicked</u> shall see it, and be <u>grieved</u>; he shall <u>gnash</u> with his <u>teeth</u>, and <u>melt away</u>: the <u>desire</u> of the wicked shall <u>perish</u>.

- 1 Praise ye the LORD. Praise, O ye servants of the LORD, praise the name of the LORD.
- 2 Blessed be the name of the LORD from this time forth and for evermore.
- 3 From the <u>rising</u> of the <u>sun</u> unto the going *down* of the same the LORD's <u>name</u> is to be <u>praised</u>.
- 4 The LORD is high above all <u>nations</u>, and his glory above the <u>heavens</u>.
- ⁵ Who is like unto the LORD our God, who <u>dwelleth</u> on *high*,
- 6 Who <u>humbleth</u> himself to <u>behold</u> the <u>things</u> that are in <u>heaven</u>, and in the <u>earth!</u>
- 7 He <u>raiseth</u> *up* the <u>poor</u> *out* of the <u>dust</u>, and <u>lifteth</u> the <u>needy</u> *out* of the <u>dunghill</u>;
- 8 That he may <u>set</u> him with <u>princes</u>, even with the princes of his people.
- 9 He maketh the barren woman to keep house, and to be a joyful mother of children. Praise ye the LORD.

- When Israel went out of Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language;
- ² Judah was his <u>sanctuary</u>, and Israel his <u>dominion</u>.
- 3 The <u>sea</u> saw it, and <u>fled</u>: **Jordan** was <u>driven</u> *back*.
- ⁴ The mountains skipped like rams, and the *little* hills like lambs.
- What <u>ailed</u> thee, O thou <u>sea</u>, that thou <u>fleddest</u>? thou Jordan, that thou wast <u>driven</u> back?
- 6 Ye mountains, that ye skipped like rams; and ye little hills, like lambs?
- ⁷ <u>Tremble</u>, thou <u>earth</u>, at the <u>presence</u> of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob;
- 8 Which <u>turned</u> the <u>rock</u> into a <u>standing water</u>, the <u>flint</u> into a <u>fountain</u> of waters.

- 1 Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, but unto thy name give glory, for thy mercy, and for thy truth's sake.
- Wherefore should the <u>heathen</u> say, Where is <u>now</u> their God?
- 3 But our God is in the <u>heavens</u>: he hath done *whatsoever* he hath <u>pleased</u>.
- 4 Their idols are silver and gold, the work of men's hands.
- They have mouths, but they speak not: eyes have they, but they see not:
- 6 They have <u>ears</u>, but they hear <u>not</u>: <u>noses</u> have they, but they <u>smell not</u>:
- They have <u>hands</u>, but they <u>handle not</u>: <u>feet</u> have they, but they <u>walk not</u>: <u>neither</u> speak they through their throat.
- They that *make* them are *like* unto them; so is <u>every one</u> that <u>trusteth</u> in them.
- 9 O Israel, trust thou in the LORD: he is their help and their shield.
- 10 O house of Aaron, trust in the LORD: he is their help and their shield.
- 11 Ye that fear the LORD, trust in the LORD: he is their help and their shield.
- 12 The LORD hath been mindful of us: he will bless us; he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of Aaron.
- 13 He will bless them that fear the LORD, both small and great.
- 14 The LORD shall increase you *more* and *more*, you and your children.
- 15 Ye are blessed of the LORD which made heaven and earth.
- 16 The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's: but the earth hath he given to the children of men.
- 17 The <u>dead praise not</u> the **LORD**, <u>neither</u> *any* that go *down* into <u>silence</u>.
- 18 But we will <u>bless</u> the **LORD** from this <u>time</u> *forth* and *for evermore*. <u>Praise</u> the **LORD**.

- 1 love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice and my supplications.
- 2 Because he hath <u>inclined</u> his <u>ear</u> unto me, therefore will I <u>call</u> upon him as *long* as I <u>live</u>.
- 3 The <u>sorrows</u> of <u>death compassed</u> me, and the <u>pains</u> of <u>hell</u> gat hold upon me: I <u>found trouble</u> and sorrow.
- ⁴ Then <u>called</u> I upon the <u>name</u> of the LORD; O LORD, I <u>beseech</u> thee, <u>deliver</u> my <u>soul</u>.
- 5 Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; yea, our God is merciful.
- 6 The LORD <u>preserveth</u> the <u>simple</u>: I was brought *low*, and he <u>helped</u> me.
- 7 Return unto thy rest, O my soul; for the LORD hath dealt bountifully with thee.
- 8 For thou hast <u>delivered</u> my <u>soul</u> from <u>death</u>, mine <u>eyes</u> from <u>tears</u>, and my <u>feet</u> from <u>falling</u>.
- 9 I will walk before the LORD in the land of the living.
- 10 I believed, therefore have I spoken: I was *greatly* afflicted:
- 11 I said in my <u>haste</u>, All men are <u>liars</u>.
- 12 What shall I <u>render</u> unto the LORD for all his <u>benefits</u> toward me?
- 13 I will take the <u>cup</u> of <u>salvation</u>, and <u>call</u> upon the <u>name</u> of the LORD.
- 14 I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people.
- 15 Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of his saints.
- 16 O LORD, *truly* I am thy <u>servant;</u> I am thy servant, and *the son of thine <u>handmaid</u>*: thou hast <u>loosed</u> my bonds.
- 17 I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD.
- 18 I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people.
- 19 In the courts of the LORD's house, in the *midst* of thee, O Jerusalem. Praise ye the LORD.

- 1 O <u>praise</u> the LORD, *all* ye <u>nations</u>: praise him, *all* ye people.
- ² For his *merciful* <u>kindness</u> is <u>great</u> *toward* us: and the <u>truth</u> of the LORD <u>endureth</u> *for ever*. <u>Praise</u> ye the LORD.

- 1 O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: because his mercy endureth for ever.
- 2 Let Israel now say, that his mercy endureth for ever.
- 3 Let the house of Aaron now say, that his mercy endureth for ever.
- 4 Let them now that <u>fear</u> the LORD say, that his <u>mercy endureth</u> for ever.
- 5 I <u>called</u> upon the LORD in <u>distress</u>: the LORD <u>answered</u> me, and <u>set</u> me in a *large* <u>place</u>.
- 6 The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?
- 7 The LORD taketh my <u>part</u> with them that <u>help</u> me: therefore shall I see my <u>desire</u> upon them that <u>hate</u> me.
- 8 It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man.
- 9 It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in princes.
- All <u>nations compassed</u> me about: but in the <u>name</u> of the <u>LORD</u> will I <u>destroy</u> them.
- ¹¹ They <u>compassed</u> me about; yea, they compassed me about: but in the <u>name</u> of the <u>LORD</u> I will <u>destroy</u> them.
- 12 They <u>compassed</u> me about like <u>bees</u>: they are <u>quenched</u> as the <u>fire</u> of <u>thorns</u>: for in the <u>name</u> of the <u>LORD</u> I will <u>destroy</u> them.
- 13 Thou hast thrust sore at me that I might fall: but the LORD helped me.
- 14 The LORD is my <u>strength</u> and <u>song</u>, and is become my <u>salvation</u>.
- 15 The <u>voice</u> of <u>rejoicing</u> and <u>salvation</u> is in the <u>tabernacles</u> of the <u>righteous</u>: the <u>right hand</u> of the <u>LORD</u> doeth <u>valiantly</u>.
- 16 The <u>right hand</u> of the **LORD** is <u>exalted</u>: the <u>right hand</u> of the **LORD** doeth *valiantly*.
- 17 I shall <u>not die</u>, but <u>live</u>, and <u>declare</u> the <u>works</u> of the LORD.
- 18 The LORD hath <u>chastened</u> me <u>sore</u>: but he hath <u>not</u> given me over unto <u>death</u>.
- 19 Open to me the gates of righteousness: I will go into them, and I will praise the LORD:
- 20 This gate of the LORD, into which the <u>righteous</u> shall <u>enter</u>.
- 21 I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation.

- 22 The stone which the builders refused is become the head stone of the corner.
- 23 This is the LORD's doing; it is <u>marvellous</u> in our <u>eyes</u>.
- 24 This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.
- 25 Save now, I beseech thee, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech thee, send now prosperity.
- ²⁶ <u>Blessed</u> be he that cometh in the <u>name</u> of the <u>LORD</u>: we have blessed you *out* of the <u>house</u> of the <u>LORD</u>.
- 27 God is the LORD, which hath shewed us <u>light</u>: <u>bind</u> the <u>sacrifice</u> with <u>cords</u>, even unto the <u>horns</u> of the altar.
- ²⁸ Thou art my God, and I will <u>praise</u> thee: thou art my God, I will <u>exalt</u> thee.
- ²⁹ O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.

- 1 Blessed are the undefiled in the way, who walk in the *law* of the LORD.
- 2 Blessed are they that keep his testimonies, and that seek him with the whole heart.
- They also do <u>no iniquity</u>: they <u>walk</u> in his <u>ways</u>.
- 4 Thou hast <u>commanded</u> us to <u>keep</u> thy <u>precepts</u> <u>diligently</u>.
- O that my ways were directed to keep thy statutes!
- 6 Then shall I <u>not</u> be <u>ashamed</u>, when I have <u>respect</u> unto *all* thy <u>commandments</u>.
- 7 I will <u>praise</u> thee with <u>uprightness</u> of <u>heart</u>, when I shall have <u>learned</u> thy <u>righteous judgments</u>.
- 8 I will <u>keep</u> thy <u>statutes</u>: O <u>forsake</u> me <u>not</u> *utterly*.
- 9 Wherewithal shall a *young* man cleanse his way? by taking heed thereto according to thy word.
- With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments.
- 11 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.
- 12 <u>Blessed</u> art thou, O <u>LORD</u>: <u>teach</u> me thy <u>statutes</u>.
- 13 With my <u>lips</u> have I <u>declared</u> *all* the <u>judgments</u> of thy <u>mouth</u>.
- 14 I have <u>rejoiced</u> in the <u>way</u> of thy <u>testimonies</u>, as *much* as in *all* <u>riches</u>.
- 15 I will meditate in thy precepts, and have respect unto thy ways.
- 16 I will <u>delight</u> myself in thy <u>statutes</u>: I will <u>not forget</u> thy <u>word</u>.
- 17 Deal bountifully with thy servant, that I may live, and keep thy word.
- 18 Open thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of thy law.
- 19 I am a <u>stranger</u> in the <u>earth</u>: <u>hide not</u> thy <u>commandments</u> from me.
- My soul breaketh for the longing that it hath unto thy judgments at all times.
- 21 Thou hast <u>rebuked</u> the <u>proud</u> that are <u>cursed</u>, which do <u>err</u> from thy <u>commandments</u>.
- 22 Remove from me reproach and contempt; for I have kept thy testimonies.
- Princes also did sit and speak against me: but thy servant did meditate in thy statutes.
- 24 Thy <u>testimonies</u> also are my <u>delight</u> and my <u>counselors</u>.
- 25 My soul cleaveth unto the dust: quicken thou me according to thy word.

- 26 I have <u>declared</u> my <u>ways</u>, and thou heardest me: <u>teach</u> me thy <u>statutes</u>.
- 27 Make me to <u>understand</u> the <u>way</u> of thy <u>precepts</u>: so shall I <u>talk</u> of thy <u>wondrous works</u>.
- 28 My <u>soul melteth</u> for <u>heaviness</u>: <u>strengthen</u> thou me according unto thy <u>word</u>.
- 29 Remove from me the <u>way</u> of <u>lying</u>: and <u>grant</u> me thy <u>law graciously</u>.
- 30 I have chosen the way of truth: thy judgments have I laid before me.
- 31 I have <u>stuck</u> unto thy <u>testimonies</u>: O LORD, put me <u>not</u> to <u>shame</u>.
- 32 I will <u>run</u> the <u>way</u> of thy <u>commandments</u>, when thou shalt <u>enlarge</u> my <u>heart</u>.
- 33 Teach me, O LORD, the way of thy statutes; and I shall keep it unto the end.
- 34 Give me <u>understanding</u>, and I shall <u>keep</u> thy <u>law</u>, yea, I shall <u>observe</u> it with my *whole* <u>heart</u>.
- 35 Make me to go in the <u>path</u> of thy <u>commandments</u>; for therein do I <u>delight</u>.
- 36 Incline my heart unto thy testimonies, and not to covetousness.
- Turn away mine eyes from beholding vanity; and quicken thou me in thy way.
- 38 <u>Stablish</u> thy <u>word</u> unto thy <u>servant</u>, who is <u>devoted</u> to thy <u>fear</u>.
- 39 <u>Turn away</u> my <u>reproach</u> which I <u>fear</u>: for thy <u>judgments</u> are <u>good</u>.
- 40 Behold, I have <u>longed</u> after thy <u>precepts</u>: <u>quicken</u> me in thy <u>righteousness</u>.
- 41 Let thy <u>mercies</u> come also unto me, O LORD, even thy <u>salvation</u>, according to thy <u>word</u>.
- 42 So shall I have *wherewith* to <u>answer</u> him that <u>reproacheth</u> me: for I <u>trust</u> in thy <u>word</u>.
- 43 And take <u>not</u> the <u>word</u> of <u>truth</u> *utterly out* of my <u>mouth</u>; for I have <u>hoped</u> in thy <u>judgments</u>.
- 44 So shall I keep thy <u>law</u> continually for ever and ever.
- 45 And I will walk at liberty: for I seek thy precepts.
- 46 I will speak of thy <u>testimonies</u> also *before* <u>kings</u>, and will <u>not</u> be <u>ashamed</u>.
- 47 And I will <u>delight</u> myself in thy <u>commandments</u>, which I have <u>loved</u>.
- ⁴⁸ My <u>hands</u> also will I <u>lift</u> up unto thy <u>commandments</u>, which I have <u>loved</u>; and I will <u>meditate</u> in thy <u>statutes</u>.
- 49 Remember the word unto thy servant, upon which thou hast caused me to hope.

- 50 This is my comfort in my affliction: for thy word hath guickened me.
- 51 The <u>proud</u> have had me *greatly* in <u>derision</u>: yet have I <u>not declined</u> from thy <u>law</u>.
- 52 I <u>remembered</u> thy <u>judgments</u> of <u>old</u>, O LORD; and have <u>comforted</u> myself.
- 53 Horror hath taken hold upon me because of the wicked that forsake thy law.
- 54 Thy <u>statutes</u> have been my <u>songs</u> in the <u>house</u> of my <u>pilgrimage</u>.
- 55 I have <u>remembered</u> thy <u>name</u>, O LORD, in the <u>night</u>, and have <u>kept</u> thy <u>law</u>.
- 56 This I had, because I kept thy precepts.
- ⁵⁷ Thou art my <u>portion</u>, O LORD: I have said that I would <u>keep</u> thy <u>words</u>.
- 58 I <u>intreated</u> thy <u>favour</u> with my <u>whole heart</u>: be <u>merciful</u> unto me according to thy <u>word</u>.
- ⁵⁹ I thought on my <u>ways</u>, and <u>turned</u> my <u>feet</u> unto thy <u>testimonies</u>.
- 60 I made <u>haste</u>, and <u>delayed not</u> to <u>keep</u> thy <u>commandments</u>.
- 61 The <u>bands</u> of the <u>wicked</u> have <u>robbed</u> me: but I have <u>not forgotten</u> thy <u>law</u>.
- 62 At midnight I will rise to give thanks unto thee because of thy righteous judgments.
- 63 I am a companion of all them that fear thee, and of them that keep thy precepts.
- 64 The <u>earth</u>, O LORD, is <u>full</u> of thy <u>mercy</u>: <u>teach</u> me thy <u>statutes</u>.
- 65 Thou hast <u>dealt well</u> with thy <u>servant</u>, O LORD, according unto thy <u>word</u>.
- Teach me good judgment and knowledge: for I have believed thy commandments.
- 67 Before I was afflicted I went astray: but now have I kept thy word.
- 68 Thou art good, and doest good; teach me thy statutes.
- 69 The <u>proud</u> have <u>forged</u> a <u>lie against</u> me: but I will <u>keep</u> thy <u>precepts</u> with my *whole* <u>heart</u>.
- Their <u>heart</u> is as <u>fat</u> as <u>grease</u>; but I <u>delight</u> in thy <u>law</u>.
- 71 It is good for me that I have been afflicted; that I might learn thy statutes.
- 72 The <u>law</u> of thy <u>mouth</u> is <u>better</u> unto me than <u>thousands</u> of <u>gold</u> and <u>silver</u>.
- 73 Thy <u>hands</u> have made me and <u>fashioned</u> me: give me <u>understanding</u>, that I may <u>learn</u> thy commandments.

- They that <u>fear</u> thee will be <u>glad</u> when they <u>see</u> me; because I have <u>hoped</u> in thy <u>word</u>.
- 75 I know, O LORD, that thy judgments are right, and that thou in faithfulness hast afflicted me.
- The Let, I pray thee, thy merciful kindness be for my comfort, according to thy word unto thy servant.
- 77 Let thy *tender* mercies come unto me, that I may live: for thy *law* is my <u>delight</u>.
- The the proud be ashamed; for they dealt perversely with me without a cause: but I will meditate in thy precepts.
- 79 Let those that <u>fear</u> thee <u>turn</u> unto me, and those that have <u>known</u> thy <u>testimonies</u>.
- 80 Let my heart be sound in thy statutes; that I be not ashamed.
- 81 My soul fainteth for thy salvation: but I hope in thy word.
- 82 Mine eyes fail for thy word, saying, When wilt thou comfort me?
- 83 For I am become like a bottle in the smoke; yet do I not forget thy statutes.
- 84 How many are the days of thy servant? when wilt thou execute judgment on them that persecute me?
- 85 The <u>proud</u> have <u>digged pits</u> for me, which are <u>not</u> *after* thy <u>law</u>.
- 86 All thy commandments are faithful: they persecute me wrongfully; help thou me.
- 87 They had almost <u>consumed</u> me upon <u>earth</u>; but I <u>forsook not</u> thy <u>precepts</u>.
- 88 Quicken me after thy lovingkindness; so shall I keep the testimony of thy mouth.
- 89 For ever, O LORD, thy word is settled in heaven.
- 90 Thy <u>faithfulness</u> is unto *all* <u>generations</u>: thou hast <u>established</u> the <u>earth</u>, and it <u>abideth</u>.
- 91 They continue this day according to thine ordinances: for all are thy servants.
- ⁹² Unless thy <u>law</u> had been my <u>delights</u>, I should then have <u>perished</u> in mine <u>affliction</u>.
- 93 I will never forget thy precepts: for with them thou hast guickened me.
- 94 I am thine, <u>save</u> me: for I have <u>sought</u> thy <u>precepts</u>.
- 95 The <u>wicked</u> have <u>waited</u> for me to <u>destroy</u> me: but I will <u>consider</u> thy <u>testimonies</u>.
- 96 I have seen an end of all perfection: but thy commandment is exceeding broad.
- ⁹⁷ O how <u>love</u> I thy <u>law</u>! it is my <u>meditation</u> all the <u>day</u>.

- 98 Thou through thy <u>commandments</u> hast made me <u>wiser</u> than mine <u>enemies</u>: for they are *ever* with me.
- 99 I have *more* <u>understanding</u> than *all* my <u>teachers</u>: for thy <u>testimonies</u> are my <u>meditation</u>.
- 100 I <u>understand</u> *more* than the <u>ancients</u>, because I <u>keep</u> thy <u>precepts</u>.
- 101 I have <u>refrained</u> my <u>feet</u> from <u>every *evil* way</u>, that I might <u>keep</u> thy <u>word</u>.
- 102 I have <u>not departed</u> from thy <u>judgments</u>: for thou hast <u>taught</u> me.
- 103 How <u>sweet</u> are thy <u>words</u> unto my <u>taste!</u> yea, <u>sweeter</u> than <u>honey</u> to my <u>mouth!</u>
- 104 Through thy <u>precepts</u> I get <u>understanding</u>: therefore I <u>hate every *false* way</u>.
- 105 Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.
- 106 I have <u>sworn</u>, and I will <u>perform</u> it, that I will <u>keep</u> thy <u>righteous judgments</u>.
- 107 I am <u>afflicted</u> very much: <u>quicken</u> me, O LORD, according unto thy <u>word</u>.
- 108 Accept, I beseech thee, the freewill offerings of my mouth, O LORD, and teach me thy judgments.
- 109 My soul is *continually* in my hand: yet do I not forget thy law.
- 110 The wicked have laid a snare for me: yet I erred not from thy precepts.
- 111 Thy testimonies have I taken as an heritage for ever. for they are the rejoicing of my heart.
- 112 I have inclined mine heart to perform thy statutes alway, even unto the end.
- 113 I hate vain thoughts: but thy <u>law</u> do I <u>love</u>.
- 114 Thou art my hiding place and my shield: I hope in thy word.
- Depart from me, ye evildoers: for I will keep the commandments of my God.
- 116 Uphold me according unto thy word, that I may live: and let me not be ashamed of my hope.
- 117 Hold thou me *up*, and I shall be <u>safe</u>: and I will have <u>respect</u> unto thy <u>statutes</u> continually.
- 118 Thou hast trodden down all them that err from thy statutes: for their deceit is falsehood.
- 119 Thou puttest away all the wicked of the earth like dross: therefore I love thy testimonies.
- 120 My <u>flesh trembleth</u> for <u>fear</u> of thee; and I am <u>afraid</u> of thy <u>judgments</u>.
- 121 I have done <u>judgment</u> and <u>justice</u>: <u>leave</u> me <u>not</u> to mine <u>oppressors</u>.
- 122 Be <u>surety</u> for thy <u>servant</u> for <u>good</u>: let <u>not</u> the <u>proud oppress</u> me.

- 123 Mine eyes fail for thy salvation, and for the word of thy righteousness.
- 124 <u>Deal</u> with thy <u>servant</u> according unto thy <u>mercy</u>, and <u>teach</u> me thy <u>statutes</u>.
- 125 I am thy <u>servant</u>; give me <u>understanding</u>, that I may <u>know</u> thy <u>testimonies</u>.
- 126 It is time for thee, LORD, to work: for they have made void thy law.
- 127 Therefore I <u>love</u> thy <u>commandments</u> *above* <u>gold</u>; yea, above <u>fine</u> *gold*.
- 128 Therefore I <u>esteem</u> all thy <u>precepts</u> concerning all things to be <u>right</u>; and I <u>hate every false way</u>.
- 129 Thy testimonies are wonderful: therefore doth my soul keep them.
- 130 The <u>entrance</u> of thy <u>words</u> giveth <u>light</u>; it giveth <u>understanding</u> unto the <u>simple</u>.
- ¹³¹ I <u>opened</u> my <u>mouth</u>, and <u>panted</u>: for I <u>longed</u> for thy <u>commandments</u>.
- 132 Look thou upon me, and be merciful unto me, as thou usest to do unto those that love thy name.
- 133 Order my steps in thy word: and let not any iniquity have dominion over me.
- Deliver me from the oppression of man: so will I keep thy precepts.
- 135 Make thy <u>face</u> to <u>shine</u> upon thy <u>servant</u>; and <u>teach</u> me thy <u>statutes</u>.
- Rivers of waters run down mine eyes, because they keep not thy law.
- 137 Righteous art thou, O LORD, and upright are thy judgments.
- 138 Thy testimonies that thou hast commanded are righteous and very faithful.
- 139 My zeal hath consumed me, because mine enemies have forgotten thy words.
- 140 Thy word is very pure: therefore thy servant loveth it.
- 141 I am small and despised: yet do not I forget thy precepts.
- 142 Thy <u>righteousness</u> is an *everlasting righteousness*, and thy <u>law</u> is the <u>truth</u>.
- 143 <u>Trouble</u> and <u>anguish</u> have taken <u>hold</u> on me: yet thy <u>commandments</u> are my <u>delights</u>.
- 144 The <u>righteousness</u> of thy <u>testimonies</u> is <u>everlasting</u>: give me <u>understanding</u>, and I shall <u>live</u>.
- 145 I <u>cried</u> with my *whole* <u>heart</u>; *hear* me, O LORD: I will <u>keep</u> thy <u>statutes</u>.
- 146 I <u>cried</u> unto thee; <u>save</u> me, and I shall <u>keep</u> thy <u>testimonies</u>.
- 147 I prevented the dawning of the morning, and cried: I hoped in thy word.

- 148 Mine eyes *prevent* the <u>night watches</u>, that I might <u>meditate</u> in thy <u>word</u>.
- 149 Hear my voice according unto thy lovingkindness: O LORD, quicken me according to thy judgment.
- 150 They <u>draw</u> *nigh* that <u>follow</u> *after* <u>mischief</u>: they are *far* from thy <u>law</u>.
- 151 Thou art *near*, O LORD; and *all* thy <u>commandments</u> are <u>truth</u>.
- 152 Concerning thy <u>testimonies</u>, I have <u>known</u> of <u>old</u> that thou hast <u>founded</u> them *for ever*.
- 153 Consider mine affliction, and deliver me: for I do not forget thy <u>law</u>.
- 154 Plead my cause, and deliver me: quicken me according to thy word.
- 155 <u>Salvation</u> is far from the <u>wicked</u>: for they <u>seek not</u> thy <u>statutes</u>.
- 156 Great are thy tender mercies, O LORD: quicken me according to thy judgments.
- 157 Many are my persecutors and mine enemies; yet do I not decline from thy testimonies.
- 158 I beheld the transgressors, and was grieved; because they kept not thy word.
- 159 Consider how I love thy precepts: quicken me, O LORD, according to thy lovingkindness.
- 160 Thy word is *true* from the <u>beginning</u>: and <u>every one</u> of thy *righteous* judgments endureth for ever.
- 161 Princes have persecuted me without a cause: but my heart standeth in awe of thy word.
- 162 I <u>rejoice</u> at thy <u>word</u>, as <u>one</u> that <u>findeth</u> <u>great spoil</u>.
- 163 I hate and abhor lying: but thy law do I love.
- Seven times a day do I praise thee because of thy righteous judgments.
- 165 Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.
- 166 LORD, I have hoped for thy salvation, and done thy commandments.
- 167 My soul hath kept thy testimonies; and I love them exceedingly.
- 168 I have <u>kept</u> thy <u>precepts</u> and thy <u>testimonies</u>: for *all* my <u>ways</u> are *before* thee.
- 169 Let my <u>cry</u> come near before thee, O <u>LORD</u>: give me <u>understanding</u> according to thy <u>word</u>.
- 170 Let my <u>supplication</u> come *before* thee: <u>deliver</u> me according to thy <u>word</u>.
- 171 My lips shall utter praise, when thou hast taught me thy statutes.
- 172 My tongue shall speak of thy word: for all thy commandments are righteousness.

- 173 Let thine <u>hand help</u> me; for I have <u>chosen</u> thy <u>precepts</u>.
- 174 I have <u>longed</u> for thy <u>salvation</u>, O LORD; and thy <u>law</u> is my <u>delight</u>.
- 175 Let my soul live, and it shall praise thee; and let thy judgments help me.
- 176 I have gone <u>astray</u> like a <u>lost sheep</u>; seek thy <u>servant</u>; for I do <u>not forget</u> thy <u>commandments</u>.

- 1 In my distress I cried unto the LORD, and he heard me.
- ² <u>Deliver</u> my <u>soul</u>, O <u>LORD</u>, from *lying* <u>lips</u>, and from a *deceitful* <u>tongue</u>.
- 3 What shall be given unto thee? or what shall be done unto thee, thou *false* tongue?
- 4 Sharp arrows of the mighty, with coals of juniper.
- 5 Woe is me, that I sojourn in Mesech, that I dwell in the tents of Kedar!
- 6 My soul hath long dwelt with him that hateth peace.
- 7 I am for <u>peace</u>: but when I speak, they are for <u>war</u>.

- 1 I will <u>lift up</u> mine <u>eyes</u> unto the <u>hills</u>, from whence cometh my <u>help</u>.
- 2 My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.
- 3 He will <u>not suffer</u> thy <u>foot</u> to be <u>moved</u>: he that <u>keepeth</u> thee will <u>not slumber</u>.
- 4 Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.
- The LORD is thy keeper: the LORD is thy shade upon thy right hand.
- 6 The <u>sun</u> shall <u>not smite</u> thee by <u>day</u>, <u>nor</u> the <u>moon</u> by <u>night</u>.
- 7 The LORD shall <u>preserve</u> thee from *all* <u>evil</u>: he shall preserve thy <u>soul</u>.
- The LORD shall preserve thy *going out* and thy *coming in* from this time forth, and even *for evermore*.

- 1 I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD.
- ² Our <u>feet</u> shall <u>stand</u> within thy <u>gates</u>, O Jerusalem.
- 3 Jerusalem is <u>builded</u> as a <u>city</u> that is <u>compact</u> together:
- Whither the <u>tribes</u> go *up*, the tribes of the LORD, unto the <u>testimony</u> of <u>Israel</u>, to give <u>thanks</u> unto the name of the LORD.
- 5 For there are <u>set thrones</u> of <u>judgment</u>, the thrones of the <u>house</u> of <u>David</u>.
- 6 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee.
- ⁷ <u>Peace</u> be within thy <u>walls</u>, and <u>prosperity</u> within thy <u>palaces</u>.
- 8 For my brethren and <u>companions'</u> sakes, I will now say, <u>Peace</u> be within thee.
- ⁹ Because of the <u>house</u> of the LORD our God I will <u>seek</u> thy good.

- 1 Unto thee <u>lift</u> I *up* mine <u>eyes</u>, O thou that <u>dwellest</u> in the <u>heavens</u>.
- 2 Behold, as the <u>eyes</u> of <u>servants</u> look unto the <u>hand</u> of their <u>masters</u>, and as the eyes of a <u>maiden</u> unto the <u>hand</u> of her <u>mistress</u>; so our eyes <u>wait</u> upon the LORD our God, until that he have <u>mercy</u> upon us.
- 3 Have mercy upon us, O LORD, have mercy upon us: for we are exceedingly filled with contempt.
- 4 Our <u>soul</u> is <u>exceedingly filled</u> with the <u>scorning</u> of those that are at <u>ease</u>, and with the <u>contempt</u> of the <u>proud</u>.

- If it had <u>not</u> been the LORD who was on our side, now may Israel say;
- 2 If it had not been the LORD who was on our side, when men rose *up* against us:
- 3 Then they had <u>swallowed</u> us *up* <u>quick</u>, when their <u>wrath</u> was <u>kindled against</u> us:
- 4 Then the <u>waters</u> had <u>overwhelmed</u> us, the <u>stream</u> had gone over our <u>soul</u>:
- ⁵ Then the proud waters had gone over our soul.
- ⁶ <u>Blessed</u> be the <u>LORD</u>, who hath <u>not</u> given us as a <u>prey</u> to their <u>teeth</u>.
- Our <u>soul</u> is <u>escaped</u> as a <u>bird</u> *out* of the <u>snare</u> of the <u>fowlers</u>: the snare is <u>broken</u>, and we are escaped.
- Our <u>help</u> is in the <u>name</u> of the LORD, who made <u>heaven</u> and <u>earth</u>.

- 1 They that <u>trust</u> in the LORD shall be as <u>mount</u> Zion, which <u>cannot</u> be <u>removed</u>, but <u>abideth</u> for ever.
- ² As the <u>mountains</u> are round about Jerusalem, so the LORD is round about his people from henceforth even *for ever*.
- ³ For the <u>rod</u> of the <u>wicked</u> shall <u>not rest</u> upon the <u>lot</u> of the <u>righteous</u>; lest the righteous put forth their <u>hands</u> unto <u>iniquity</u>.
- ⁴ Do good, O LORD, unto those that be good, and to them that are <u>upright</u> in their <u>hearts</u>.
- 5 As for such as <u>turn</u> aside unto their <u>crooked ways</u>, the LORD shall <u>lead</u> them forth with the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u>: but <u>peace</u> shall be upon <u>Israel</u>.

- 1 When the LORD <u>turned again</u> the <u>captivity</u> of **Zion**, we were like them that <u>dream</u>.
- ² Then was our <u>mouth filled</u> with <u>laughter</u>, and our <u>tongue</u> with <u>singing</u>: then said they among the <u>heathen</u>, The LORD hath done <u>great things</u> for them.
- 3 The LORD hath done *great* things for us; whereof we are glad.
- ⁴ <u>Turn again</u> our <u>captivity</u>, O LORD, as the <u>streams</u> in the <u>south</u>.
- 5 They that <u>sow</u> in <u>tears</u> shall <u>reap</u> in joy.
- 6 He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.

- 1 Except the LORD <u>build</u> the <u>house</u>, they <u>labour</u> in <u>vain</u> that build it: except the LORD <u>keep</u> the <u>city</u>, the <u>watchman waketh</u> but in vain.
- 2 It is <u>vain</u> for you to <u>rise</u> <u>up early</u>, to <u>sit up late</u>, to <u>eat</u> the <u>bread</u> of <u>sorrows</u>: for so he giveth his <u>beloved</u> <u>sleep</u>.
- 3 Lo, children are an heritage of the LORD: and the <u>fruit of the womb</u> is his <u>reward</u>.
- 4 As <u>arrows</u> are in the <u>hand</u> of a *mighty* <u>man</u>; so are <u>children</u> of the <u>youth</u>.
- 5 Happy is the man that hath his quiver full of them: they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate.

- 1 Blessed is every one that feareth the LORD; that walketh in his ways.
- 2 For thou shalt <u>eat</u> the <u>labour</u> of thine <u>hands</u>: <u>happy</u> shalt thou be, and it shall be <u>well</u> with thee.
- Thy wife shall be as a fruitful vine by the sides of thine house: thy children like olive plants round about thy table.
- 4 Behold, that thus shall the man be blessed that feareth the LORD.
- 5 The LORD shall <u>bless</u> thee *out* of Zion: and thou shalt see the good of Jerusalem all the days of thy <u>life</u>.
- Yea, thou shalt *see* thy children's *children*, and <u>peace</u> upon Israel.

- 1 Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth, may Israel now say:
- 2 Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth: yet they have not prevailed against me.
- 3 The <u>plowers plowed</u> upon my <u>back</u>: they made *long* their <u>furrows</u>.
- 4 The LORD is righteous: he hath cut asunder the cords of the wicked.
- 5 Let them *all* be confounded and turned *back* that hate **Zion**.
- 6 Let them be as the grass upon the housetops, which withereth afore it groweth up:
- 7 Wherewith the mower filleth not his hand; nor he that bindeth sheaves his bosom.
- 8 <u>Neither</u> do they which go by say, The <u>blessing</u> of the <u>LORD</u> be upon you: we <u>bless</u> you in the <u>name</u> of the <u>LORD</u>.

- 1 Out of the depths have I cried unto thee, O LORD.
- 2 Lord, hear my voice: let thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications.
- 3 If thou, LORD, shouldest mark iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand?
- 4 But there is <u>forgiveness</u> with thee, that thou mayest be <u>feared</u>.
- ⁵ I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope.
- 6 My soul waiteth for the Lord *more* than they that watch for the morning: I say, *more* than they that watch for the morning.
- 7 Let Israel hope in the LORD: for with the LORD there is mercy, and with him is plenteous redemption.
- 8 And he shall <u>redeem</u> <u>Israel</u> from <u>all</u> his <u>iniquities</u>.

- 1 Lord, my heart is not haughty, nor mine eyes lofty: neither do I exercise myself in great matters, or in things too high for me.
- ² Surely I have <u>behaved</u> and <u>quieted</u> myself, as a child that is <u>weaned</u> of his <u>mother</u>: my <u>soul</u> is even as a weaned child.
- 3 Let Israel hope in the LORD from henceforth and for ever.

- 1 Lord, remember David, and all his afflictions:
- 2 How he <u>sware</u> unto the <u>LORD</u>, and <u>vowed</u> unto the <u>mighty God</u> of <u>Jacob</u>;
- 3 Surely I will not come into the tabernacle of my house, nor go up into my bed;
- 4 I will not give sleep to mine eyes, or slumber to mine eyelids,
- ⁵ Until I find out a place for the LORD, an habitation for the mighty God of Jacob.
- 6 Lo, we *heard* of it at **Ephratah**: we <u>found</u> it in the <u>fields</u> of the <u>wood</u>.
- 7 We will go into his <u>tabernacles</u>: we will <u>worship</u> at his <u>footstool</u>.
- 8 Arise, O LORD, into thy rest; thou, and the ark of thy strength.
- 9 Let thy <u>priests</u> be <u>clothed</u> with <u>righteousness</u>; and let thy <u>saints shout</u> for <u>joy</u>.
- 10 For thy <u>servant</u> David's sake <u>turn not away</u> the <u>face</u> of thine <u>anointed</u>.
- 11 The LORD hath sworn in truth unto David; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne.
- 12 If thy children will keep my covenant and my testimony that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon thy throne for evermore.
- 13 For the LORD hath chosen Zion; he hath desired it for his habitation.
- 14 This is my <u>rest</u> for ever: here will I <u>dwell</u>; for I have <u>desired</u> it.
- 15 I will abundantly bless her provision: I will satisfy her poor with bread.
- 16 I will also <u>clothe</u> her <u>priests</u> with <u>salvation</u>: and her <u>saints</u> shall <u>shout</u> *aloud* for <u>joy</u>.
- 17 There will I make the <u>horn</u> of <u>David</u> to <u>bud</u>: I have <u>ordained</u> a <u>lamp</u> for mine <u>anointed</u>.
- 18 His <u>enemies</u> will I <u>clothe</u> with <u>shame</u>: but upon himself shall his <u>crown flourish</u>.

- Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!
- 2 It is like the *precious* ointment upon the <u>head</u>, that <u>ran</u> down upon the <u>beard</u>, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the <u>skirts</u> of his <u>garments</u>;
- 3 As the <u>dew</u> of Hermon, and as the dew that <u>descended</u> upon the <u>mountains</u> of Zion: for there the LORD <u>commanded</u> the <u>blessing</u>, even <u>life</u> *for evermore*.

- 1 Behold, <u>bless</u> ye the LORD, *all* ye <u>servants</u> of the LORD, which by <u>night stand</u> in the <u>house</u> of the LORD.
- 2 <u>Lift up</u> your <u>hands</u> in the <u>sanctuary</u>, and <u>bless</u> the LORD.
- 3 The LORD that made <u>heaven</u> and <u>earth bless</u> thee *out* of Zion.

- ¹ Praise ye the LORD. Praise ye the name of the LORD; praise him, O ye servants of the LORD.
- 2 Ye that <u>stand</u> in the <u>house</u> of the <u>LORD</u>, in the <u>courts</u> of the house of our <u>God</u>.
- 3 Praise the LORD; for the LORD is good: sing praises unto his name; for it is pleasant.
- ⁴ For the LORD hath <u>chosen</u> Jacob unto himself, and Israel for his <u>peculiar treasure</u>.
- 5 For I know that the LORD is great, and that our Lord is above all gods.
- 6 Whatsoever the LORD <u>pleased</u>, that did he in <u>heaven</u>, and in <u>earth</u>, in the <u>seas</u>, and *all deep* <u>places</u>.
- The causeth the <u>vapours</u> to <u>ascend</u> from the <u>ends</u> of the <u>earth</u>; he maketh <u>lightnings</u> for the <u>rain</u>; he bringeth the <u>wind</u> *out* of his <u>treasuries</u>.
- 8 Who smote the firstborn of Egypt, both of man and beast.
- Who sent tokens and wonders into the midst of thee, O Egypt, upon Pharaoh, and upon all his servants.
- Who <u>smote</u> great <u>nations</u>, and <u>slew</u> mighty <u>kings</u>;
- 11 Sihon king of the Amorites, and Og king of Bashan, and all the kingdoms of Canaan:
- 12 And gave their land for an heritage, an heritage unto Israel his people.
- 13 Thy <u>name</u>, O LORD, <u>endureth</u> *for ever*; and thy <u>memorial</u>, O LORD, throughout *all* <u>generations</u>.
- 14 For the LORD will judge his people, and he will repent himself concerning his servants.
- 15 The idols of the heathen are silver and gold, the work of men's hands.
- 16 They have mouths, but they speak not; eyes have they, but they see not;
- They have <u>ears</u>, but they hear <u>not</u>; <u>neither</u> is there <u>any breath</u> in their <u>mouths</u>.
- 18 They that *make* them are *like* unto them: so is <u>every one</u> that <u>trusteth</u> in them.
- 19 Bless the LORD, O house of Israel: bless the LORD, O house of Aaron:
- 20 Bless the LORD, O house of Levi: ye that fear the LORD, bless the LORD.
- 21 <u>Blessed</u> be the LORD out of Zion, which <u>dwelleth</u> at <u>Jerusalem</u>. <u>Praise</u> ye the LORD.

- 1 O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- 2 O give thanks unto the God of gods: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- 3 O give thanks to the Lord of lords: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- 4 To him who *alone* doeth *great* wonders: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> for ever.
- 5 To him that by wisdom made the heavens: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- 6 To him that stretched *out* the earth *above* the waters: for his mercy endureth *for ever*.
- 7 To him that made *great* <u>lights</u>: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> *for ever*.
- 8 The <u>sun</u> to <u>rule</u> by <u>day</u>: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> *for ever*.
- The moon and stars to rule by night: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- 10 To him that <u>smote</u> **Egypt** in their <u>firstborn</u>: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> *for ever*.
- 11 And brought *out* Israel from among them: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> for ever.
- 12 With a *strong* <u>hand</u>, and with a <u>stretched</u> *out* <u>arm</u>: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> *for ever*.
- 13 To him which <u>divided</u> the **Red sea** into <u>parts</u>: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> for ever.
- 14 And made Israel to pass through the midst of it: for his mercy endureth *for ever*.
- 15 But overthrew Pharaoh and his host in the Red sea: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- 16 To him which led his people through the <u>wilderness</u>: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> *for ever*.
- 17 To him which smote great kings: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- 18 And <u>slew famous kings</u>: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> for ever.
- 19 Sihon king of the Amorites: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- And Og the king of Bashan: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- And gave their <u>land</u> for an <u>heritage</u>: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> for ever.
- 22 Even an heritage unto Israel his servant: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- 23 Who <u>remembered</u> us in our *low* <u>estate</u>: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> *for ever*.
- 24 And hath <u>redeemed</u> us from our <u>enemies</u>: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> *for ever*.
- 25 Who giveth <u>food</u> to *all* <u>flesh</u>: for his <u>mercy endureth</u> for ever. 26 O give <u>thanks</u> unto the <u>God</u> of <u>heaven</u>: for his mercy endureth for ever.

- 1 By the <u>rivers</u> of Babylon, there we <u>sat down</u>, yea, we <u>wept</u>, when we <u>remembered</u> Zion.
- 2 We <u>hanged</u> our <u>harps</u> upon the <u>willows</u> in the midst thereof.
- ³ For there they that <u>carried</u> us <u>away captive required</u> of us a <u>song</u>; and they that <u>wasted</u> us <u>required</u> of us <u>mirth</u>, saying, <u>Sing</u> us one of the songs of Zion.
- 4 How shall we sing the LORD's song in a strange land?
- 5 If I forget thee, O Jerusalem, let my right hand forget her cunning.
- 6 If I do <u>not remember</u> thee, let my <u>tongue cleave</u> to the <u>roof</u> of my <u>mouth</u>; if I <u>prefer not</u> **Jerusalem** *above* my *chief* <u>joy</u>.
- ⁷ Remember, O LORD, the children of Edom in the <u>day</u> of Jerusalem; who said, <u>Rase</u> it, rase it, even to the <u>foundation</u> thereof.
- O daughter of Babylon, who art to be <u>destroyed</u>; <u>happy</u> shall he be, that <u>rewardeth</u> thee as thou hast <u>served</u> us.
- 9 Happy shall he be, that taketh and dasheth thy little ones against the stones.

- 1 I will <u>praise</u> thee with my *whole* <u>heart</u>: before the gods will I <u>sing</u> praise unto thee.
- 2 I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth: for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name.
- 3 In the day when I cried thou answeredst me, and strengthenedst me with strength in my soul.
- 4 A// the kings of the earth shall praise thee, O LORD, when they hear the words of thy mouth.
- Yea, they shall <u>sing</u> in the <u>ways</u> of the <u>LORD</u>: for <u>great</u> is the <u>glory</u> of the <u>LORD</u>.
- Though the LORD be *high*, yet hath he <u>respect</u> unto the *lowly*: but the <u>proud</u> he <u>knoweth</u> *afar off*.
- Though I <u>walk</u> in the <u>midst</u> of <u>trouble</u>, thou wilt <u>revive</u> me: thou shalt <u>stretch</u> forth thine <u>hand against</u> the <u>wrath</u> of mine <u>enemies</u>, and thy <u>right hand</u> shall <u>save</u> me.
- The LORD will <u>perfect</u> that which <u>concerneth</u> me: thy <u>mercy</u>, O LORD, <u>endureth</u> *for ever*: <u>forsake not</u> the <u>works</u> of thine *own* <u>hands</u>.

- ¹ O lord, thou hast <u>searched</u> me, and <u>known</u> me.
- 2 Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off.
- Thou <u>compassest</u> my <u>path</u> and my <u>lying down</u>, and art <u>acquainted</u> with <u>all</u> my <u>ways</u>.
- ⁴ For there is <u>not</u> a <u>word</u> in my <u>tongue</u>, but, lo, O <u>LORD</u>, thou <u>knowest</u> it altogether.
- 5 Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid thine hand upon me.
- Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain unto it.
- Whither shall I go from thy <u>spirit</u>? or whither shall I <u>flee</u> from thy <u>presence</u>?
- 8 If I <u>ascend</u> *up* into <u>heaven</u>, thou art there: if I make my <u>bed</u> in <u>hell</u>, behold, thou art there.
- 9 If I take the <u>wings</u> of the <u>morning</u>, and <u>dwell</u> in the *uttermost* <u>parts</u> of the <u>sea</u>;
- 10 Even there shall thy <u>hand lead</u> me, and thy <u>right hand</u> shall <u>hold</u> me.
- 11 If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about me.
- 12 Yea, the <u>darkness hideth not</u> from thee; but the <u>night shineth</u> as the <u>day</u>: the darkness and the <u>light</u> are both alike to thee.
- 13 For thou hast <u>possessed</u> my <u>reins</u>: thou hast <u>covered</u> me in my <u>mother's womb</u>.
- 14 I will <u>praise</u> thee; for I am *fearfully* and *wonderfully* made: <u>marvellous</u> are thy <u>works</u>; and that my <u>soul</u> <u>knoweth right well</u>.
- 15 My <u>substance</u> was <u>not hid</u> from thee, when I was made in <u>secret</u>, and <u>curiously wrought</u> in the <u>lowest parts</u> of the <u>earth</u>.
- 16 Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all my members were written, which in continuance were fashioned, when as yet there was none of them.
- 17 How <u>precious</u> also are thy <u>thoughts</u> unto me, O God! how <u>great</u> is the <u>sum</u> of them!
- 18 If I should <u>count</u> them, they are *more* in <u>number</u> than the <u>sand</u>: when I <u>awake</u>, I am still with thee.
- ¹⁹ Surely thou wilt <u>slay</u> the <u>wicked</u>, O God: <u>depart</u> from me therefore, ye <u>bloody men</u>.
- 20 For they speak <u>against</u> thee *wickedly*, and thine <u>enemies</u> take thy <u>name</u> in <u>vain</u>.
- 21 Do not I hate them, O LORD, that hate thee? and am not I grieved with those that rise up against thee?
- 22 I hate them with perfect hatred. I count them mine enemies.
- 23 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:
- ²⁴ And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

- 1 Deliver me, O LORD, from the *evil* man: preserve me from the *violent* man;
- 2 Which <u>imagine mischiefs</u> in their <u>heart</u>; *continually* are they <u>gathered</u> together for <u>war</u>.
- They have <u>sharpened</u> their <u>tongues</u> like a <u>serpent</u>; <u>adders' poison</u> is *under* their <u>lips</u>. *Selah*.
- ⁴ Keep me, O LORD, from the <u>hands</u> of the <u>wicked</u>; <u>preserve</u> me from the <u>violent man</u>; who have <u>purposed</u> to <u>overthrow</u> my goings.
- The <u>proud</u> have <u>hid</u> a <u>snare</u> for me, and <u>cords</u>; they have <u>spread</u> a <u>net</u> by the <u>wayside</u>; they have set <u>gins</u> for me. *Selah*.
- 6 I said unto the LORD, Thou art my God: hear the voice of my supplications, O LORD.
- 7 O GOD the Lord, the <u>strength</u> of my <u>salvation</u>, thou hast <u>covered</u> my <u>head</u> in the <u>day</u> of <u>battle</u>.
- 8 Grant not, O LORD, the desires of the wicked: further not his wicked device; lest they exalt themselves.
 Selah.
- 9 As for the <u>head</u> of those that <u>compass</u> me about, let the <u>mischief</u> of their *own* <u>lips cover</u> them.
- 10 Let burning coals fall upon them: let them be cast into the fire; into deep pits, that they rise not up again.
- 11 Let not an evil speaker be established in the earth: evil shall hunt the violent man to overthrow him.
- 12 I know that the LORD will maintain the cause of the afflicted, and the right of the poor.
- 13 Surely the righteous shall give thanks unto thy name: the upright shall dwell in thy presence.

- 1 Lord, I cry unto thee: make haste unto me; give ear unto my voice, when I cry unto thee.
- ² Let my <u>prayer</u> be <u>set</u> forth *before* thee as <u>incense</u>; and the <u>lifting</u> *up* of my <u>hands</u> as the <u>evening</u> sacrifice.
- 3 Set a watch, O LORD, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips.
- ⁴ Incline not my heart to any evil thing, to practise wicked works with men that work iniquity: and let me not eat of their dainties.
- ⁵ Let the <u>righteous smite</u> me; it shall be a <u>kindness</u>: and let him <u>reprove</u> me; it shall be an <u>excellent oil</u>, which shall <u>not break</u> my <u>head</u>: for yet my <u>prayer</u> also shall be in their <u>calamities</u>.
- 6 When their <u>judges</u> are <u>overthrown</u> in <u>stony</u> <u>places</u>, they shall hear my <u>words</u>; for they are <u>sweet</u>.
- Our bones are scattered at the grave's mouth, as when one cutteth and cleaveth wood upon the earth.
- 8 But mine eyes are unto thee, O GOD the Lord: in thee is my trust; leave not my soul destitute.
- ⁹ Keep me from the <u>snares</u> which they have <u>laid</u> for me, and the <u>gins</u> of the <u>workers</u> of <u>iniquity</u>.
- 10 Let the <u>wicked fall</u> into their *own* <u>nets</u>, whilst that I withal <u>escape</u>.

- 1 I <u>cried</u> unto the LORD with my <u>voice</u>; with my voice unto the LORD did I make my <u>supplication</u>.
- 2 I <u>poured</u> out my <u>complaint</u> before him; I shewed before him my <u>trouble</u>.
- 3 When my <u>spirit</u> was <u>overwhelmed</u> within me, then thou <u>knewest</u> my <u>path</u>. In the <u>way</u> wherein I <u>walked</u> have they <u>privily laid</u> a <u>snare</u> for me.
- 4 I looked on my <u>right hand</u>, and beheld, but there was <u>no man</u> that would <u>know</u> me: <u>refuge failed</u> me; <u>no</u> man <u>cared</u> for my <u>soul</u>.
- 5 I <u>cried</u> unto thee, O LORD: I said, Thou art my <u>refuge</u> and my <u>portion</u> in the <u>land</u> of the <u>living</u>.
- 6 <u>Attend</u> unto my <u>cry</u>; for I am brought <u>very low</u>. <u>deliver</u> me from my <u>persecutors</u>; for they are <u>stronger</u> than I.
- The Bring my soul out of prison, that I may praise thy name: the righteous shall compass me about; for thou shalt deal bountifully with me.

- Hear my <u>prayer</u>, O LORD, give <u>ear</u> to my <u>supplications</u>: in thy <u>faithfulness answer</u> me, and in thy <u>righteousness</u>.
- 2 And enter not into judgment with thy servant: for in thy sight shall no man living be justified.
- ³ For the <u>enemy</u> hath <u>persecuted</u> my <u>soul</u>; he hath <u>smitten</u> my <u>life</u> <u>down</u> to the <u>ground</u>; he hath made me to <u>dwell</u> in <u>darkness</u>, as those that have been <u>long dead</u>.
- 4 Therefore is my <u>spirit overwhelmed</u> within me; my <u>heart</u> within me is <u>desolate</u>.
- 5 I <u>remember</u> the <u>days</u> of <u>old</u>; I <u>meditate</u> on <u>all</u> thy <u>works</u>; I <u>muse</u> on the <u>work</u> of thy <u>hands</u>.
- 6 I <u>stretch</u> forth my <u>hands</u> unto thee: my <u>soul thirsteth</u> *after* thee, as a <u>thirsty land</u>. *Selah*.
- Thear me speedily, O LORD: my spirit faileth: hide not thy face from me, lest I be like unto them that go down into the pit.
- Cause me to hear thy <u>lovingkindness</u> in the <u>morning</u>; for in thee do I <u>trust</u>: cause me to <u>know</u> the <u>way</u> wherein I should <u>walk</u>; for I <u>lift up</u> my <u>soul</u> unto thee.
- 9 <u>Deliver</u> me, O <u>LORD</u>, from mine <u>enemies</u>: I <u>flee</u> unto thee to <u>hide</u> me.
- 10 Teach me to do thy will; for thou art my God: thy spirit is good; lead me into the land of uprightness.
- 11 Quicken me, O LORD, for thy name's sake: for thy righteousness' sake bring my soul out of trouble.
- 12 And of thy mercy cut off mine enemies, and destroy all them that afflict my soul: for I am thy servant.

- 1 <u>Blessed</u> be the <u>LORD</u> my <u>strength</u> which <u>teacheth</u> my <u>hands</u> to <u>war</u>, and my <u>fingers</u> to <u>fight</u>:
- 2 My goodness, and my fortress; my high tower, and my deliverer; my shield, and he in whom I trust; who subdueth my people under me.
- ³ LORD, what is <u>man</u>, that thou takest <u>knowledge</u> of him! or the son of man, that thou makest <u>account</u> of him!
- 4 Man is like to vanity: his days are as a shadow that passeth away.
- 5 Bow thy heavens, O LORD, and come down: touch the mountains, and they shall smoke.
- 6 Cast forth lightning, and scatter them: shoot out thine arrows, and destroy them.
- 7 <u>Send</u> thine <u>hand</u> from *above*; <u>rid</u> me, and <u>deliver</u> me *out* of <u>great waters</u>, from the <u>hand</u> of <u>strange</u> children;
- 8 Whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand is a right hand of falsehood.
- 9 I will <u>sing</u> a <u>new song</u> unto thee, O God: upon a <u>psaltery</u> and an <u>instrument</u> of <u>ten strings</u> will I sing <u>praises</u> unto thee.
- 10 It is he that giveth <u>salvation</u> unto <u>kings</u>: who <u>delivereth</u> <u>David</u> his <u>servant</u> from the <u>hurtful</u> <u>sword</u>.
- 11 Rid me, and deliver me from the hand of strange children, whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand is a right hand of falsehood:
- 12 That our sons may be as <u>plants grown</u> *up* in their <u>youth</u>; that our daughters may be as <u>corner stones</u>, <u>polished</u> <u>after the similitude</u> of a <u>palace</u>:
- 13 That our <u>garners</u> may be <u>full</u>, affording <u>all manner</u> of <u>store</u>: that our <u>sheep</u> may bring forth <u>thousands</u> and <u>ten thousands</u> in our <u>streets</u>:
- 14 That our <u>oxen</u> may be <u>strong</u> to <u>labour</u>; that there be <u>no breaking</u> *in*, <u>nor</u> going *out*, that there be <u>no complaining</u> in our <u>streets</u>.
- 15 Happy is that people, that is in such a case: yea, happy is that people, whose God is the LORD.

- 1 I will extol thee, my God, O king; and I will bless thy name for ever and ever.
- 2 Every <u>day</u> will I <u>bless</u> thee; and I will <u>praise</u> thy <u>name</u> for ever and ever.
- 3 Great is the LORD, and *greatly* to be <u>praised</u>; and his <u>greatness</u> is <u>unsearchable</u>.
- 4 One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts.
- 5 I will speak of the *glorious* honour of thy <u>majesty</u>, and of thy <u>wondrous</u> works.
- 6 And men shall speak of the might of thy terrible acts: and I will declare thy greatness.
- They shall abundantly utter the memory of thy great goodness, and shall sing of thy righteousness.
- 8 The LORD is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.
- 9 The LORD is good to alt. and his tender mercies are over all his works.
- 10 All thy works shall praise thee, O LORD; and thy saints shall bless thee.
- 11 They shall speak of the glory of thy kingdom, and talk of thy power;
- 12 To make known to the sons of men his *mighty* acts, and the *glorious* majesty of his kingdom.
- 13 Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion endureth throughout all generations.
- 14 The LORD upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all those that be bowed down.
- 15 The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season.
- 16 Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing.
- 17 The LORD is <u>righteous</u> in *all* his <u>ways</u>, and <u>holy</u> in *all* his <u>works</u>.
- 18 The LORD is *nigh* unto *all* them that <u>call</u> upon him, to *all* that call upon him in <u>truth</u>.
- 19 He will <u>fulfil</u> the <u>desire</u> of them that <u>fear</u> him: he also will hear their <u>cry</u>, and will <u>save</u> them.
- 20 The LORD preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.
- 21 My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD: and let all flesh bless his holy name for ever and ever.

- ¹ Praise ye the LORD. Praise the LORD, O my soul.
- 2 While I <u>live</u> will I <u>praise</u> the LORD: I will <u>sing praises</u> unto my **God** while I have *any being*.
- Put <u>not</u> your <u>trust</u> in <u>princes</u>, <u>nor</u> in the son of <u>man</u>, in whom there is <u>no help</u>.
- 4 His breath goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day his thoughts perish.
- 5 Happy is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the LORD his God:
- 6 Which made <u>heaven</u>, and <u>earth</u>, the <u>sea</u>, and *all* that therein is: which <u>keepeth truth</u> for ever.
- ⁷ Which <u>executeth judgment</u> for the <u>oppressed</u>: which giveth <u>food</u> to the <u>hungry</u>. The <u>LORD looseth</u> the <u>prisoners</u>:
- The LORD <u>openeth</u> the <u>eyes</u> of the <u>blind</u>: the LORD <u>raiseth</u> them that are <u>bowed</u> <u>down</u>: the LORD <u>loveth</u> the <u>righteous</u>:
- The LORD <u>preserveth</u> the <u>strangers</u>; he <u>relieveth</u> the <u>fatherless</u> and <u>widow</u>: but the <u>way</u> of the <u>wicked</u> he <u>turneth</u> upside *down*.
- 10 The LORD shall reign for ever, even thy God, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise ye the LORD.

- Praise ye the LORD: for it is good to sing praises unto our God; for it is pleasant; and praise is comely.
- 2 The LORD doth <u>build</u> *up* Jerusalem: he <u>gathereth</u> together the <u>outcasts</u> of Israel.
- 3 He <u>healeth</u> the <u>broken</u> in <u>heart</u>, and <u>bindeth</u> *up* their <u>wounds</u>.
- 4 He <u>telleth</u> the <u>number</u> of the <u>stars</u>; he <u>calleth</u> them *all* by their <u>names</u>.
- 5 Great is our Lord, and of *great* power: his <u>understanding</u> is <u>infinite</u>.
- 6 The LORD <u>lifteth</u> *up* the <u>meek</u>: he <u>casteth</u> the <u>wicked</u> *down* to the <u>ground</u>.
- 7 Sing unto the LORD with thanksgiving; sing praise upon the harp unto our God:
- 8 Who <u>covereth</u> the <u>heaven</u> with <u>clouds</u>, who <u>prepareth rain</u> for the <u>earth</u>, who maketh <u>grass</u> to <u>grow</u> upon the mountains.
- 9 He giveth to the <u>beast</u> his <u>food</u>, and to the <u>young ravens</u> which <u>cry</u>.
- 10 He delighteth not in the strength of the horse: he taketh not pleasure in the legs of a man.
- 11 The LORD taketh <u>pleasure</u> in them that <u>fear</u> him, in those that <u>hope</u> in his <u>mercy</u>.
- 12 Praise the LORD, O Jerusalem; praise thy God, O Zion.
- 13 For he hath <u>strengthened</u> the <u>bars</u> of thy <u>gates</u>; he hath <u>blessed</u> thy children within thee.
- 14 He maketh <u>peace</u> in thy <u>borders</u>, and <u>filleth</u> thee with the <u>finest</u> of the <u>wheat</u>.
- 15 He sendeth forth his commandment upon earth: his word runneth very swiftly.
- 16 He giveth snow like wool: he scattereth the hoarfrost like ashes.
- 17 He <u>casteth</u> forth his <u>ice</u> like <u>morsels</u>: who can <u>stand</u> *before* his <u>cold</u>?
- 18 He sendeth out his word, and melteth them: he causeth his wind to blow, and the waters flow.
- 19 He sheweth his word unto Jacob, his statutes and his judgments unto Israel.
- 20 He hath <u>not dealt</u> so with <u>any nation</u>: and as for his <u>judgments</u>, they have <u>not known</u> them. <u>Praise</u> ye the **LORD**.

- ¹ Praise ye the LORD. Praise ye the LORD from the <u>heavens</u>: praise him in the <u>heights</u>.
- ² Praise ye him, all his angels: praise ye him, all his hosts.
- 3 Praise ye him, sun and moon: praise him, all ye stars of light.
- ⁴ Praise him, ye heavens of *heavens*, and ye waters that be *above* the *heavens*.
- 5 Let them <u>praise</u> the <u>name</u> of the LORD: for he <u>commanded</u>, and they were <u>created</u>.
- 6 He hath also <u>stablished</u> them for ever and ever. he hath made a <u>decree</u> which shall <u>not pass</u>.
- 7 Praise the LORD from the earth, ye dragons, and all deeps:
- 8 Fire, and hail; snow, and vapours; stormy wind fulfilling his word:
- 9 Mountains, and all hills; fruitful trees, and all cedars:
- 10 Beasts, and all cattle; creeping things, and flying fowl:
- 11 Kings of the earth, and all people; princes, and all judges of the earth:
- 12 Both *young* men, and maidens; *old* men, and children:
- 13 Let them <u>praise</u> the <u>name</u> of the LORD: for his name *alone* is <u>excellent</u>; his <u>glory</u> is *above* the <u>earth</u> and <u>heaven</u>.
- 14 He also <u>exalteth</u> the <u>horn</u> of his people, the <u>praise</u> of *all* his <u>saints</u>; even of the children of <u>Israel</u>, a people *near* unto him. Praise ye the <u>LORD</u>.

- 1 Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise in the congregation of saints.
- 2 Let Israel rejoice in him that made him: let the children of Zion be joyful in their King.
- 3 Let them praise his name in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp.
- ⁴ For the LORD taketh <u>pleasure</u> in his people: he will <u>beautify</u> the <u>meek</u> with <u>salvation</u>.
- 5 Let the <u>saints</u> be <u>joyful</u> in <u>glory</u>: let them <u>sing</u> *aloud* upon their <u>beds</u>.
- 6 Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand;
- 7 To execute vengeance upon the heathen, and punishments upon the people;
- 8 To bind their kings with *chains*, and their nobles with *fetters* of iron;
- ⁹ To <u>execute</u> upon them the <u>judgment written</u>: this <u>honour</u> have <u>all</u> his <u>saints</u>. <u>Praise</u> ye the LORD.

- 1 Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power.
- ² Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness.
- 3 Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp.
- 4 Praise him with the timbrel and dance: praise him with stringed instruments and organs.
- 5 Praise him upon the loud cymbals: praise him upon the high sounding cymbals.
- 6 Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD.
